Here are some general instructions for those who want to set up the Online Bill Pay feature:

- 1) Log in to your Online Banking with your username and password.
- 2) Locate the Bill Pay service tab.
- 3) Add/Modify "St. Jude Thaddeus/Christ the King/ St. Paul Catholic Church" as a payee.
- 4) Church address is 600 Davey Drive, Burkburnett, TX 76354. Office phone number is 940 569 1222.
- 5) Label the memo line or account information as "DONATION" or "BUILDING FUND" – for accurate account recording.
- 6) Setup the frequency - weekly, twice a month, or monthly.
- 7) Confirm the starting date and setup. If you need assistance or more information, please call the Office at 940 569 1222. Your banking institution will be able to help you as well. Thank you for your generosity.
